TREASURERS REPORT

MEETING 18th MARCH 2019

February was the first full month back at school for Term 1. Overall it has been a relatively quiet month in regards to payments made by the P&C.

The main expense paid for February was the Auditors fees and a small amount of uniform stock, along with the general monthly running expenses such as rubbish removal from markets and other minor expenses.

Our monthly bookkeeping fee remains around an average of \$300 per month which includes general monthly data entry, fortnightly wages processing and quarterly BAS lodgements and other minor advice as required throughout the year.

Income from the markets during February was approx. \$1,625.75 per week.

Uniform sales were \$3,543.86 for February. Tuckshop Food Sales were \$5,559.76 for the month.
