Our Playgroup continues to include material from 3a Abacedarian Approach Australia. 3a is a research aligned approach that focuses on simple but purposeful interactions between care givers and children.



We incorporate Learning Games in our Newsletter each week for you to try at home with your child. If your child plays these games by themselves, they will learn. However, YOU can make this learning so much more, by playing the game with your child. Think of the 3N approach (Notice, Nudge, Narrate) that we discussed last week to help if you can't think of what to say to your child. But remember, you are your child's first and most important teacher. This means you already know so many ways to talk to them. We offer these suggestions to add to your repertoire.

Talking and playing are ways young children learn. Parents who provide plenty of opportunities for their children to play and spend lots of time talking and playing with them each day are giving their children the best possible support for learning.

We have thoroughly enjoyed seeing you enjoying quality time with your children each week. We hope that you have a safe and restful break and enjoy lots of playing and talking with your children.


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Please feel free to take a copy of this week's learning games when you join us on Thursday...





The focus for this week's Learning games is on playing outside in the garden.

Learning Game 3 "Show Baby Something Interesting" helps babies from birth to 6 months learn to use their eyes to look at things. They learn to hold up their head and this helps their neck muscles grow strong. They learn to like soft talk and calm strokes. They learn to feel safe.

Learning Game 21 "Hide and Find" helps babies aged between 6 and 12 months learn to look for things and find things. They learn to hear and understand new words. They learn to have fun.

Learning Game 60 "Learning Outside" helps children aged between 1 and 2 years learn words understand their world. They learn new words to describe things in their world. They learn new words to describe their play.

Learning Game 88 "In, Out and Around" helps children aged between 2 and 3 years learn to understand and follow directions. They learn that words talk about actions and positions.

Learning Game 108 "Planting Together" helps children aged between 3 and 4 years learn about responsibility. They learn about sharing tasks and to co-operate.

Learning Game 154 "Find and Collect" helps children aged between 4 and 5 years learn to notice things around them. They learn to stay interested in things over time. They learn to develop their own likes and dislikes.

The 3N's: Notice, Nudge, Narrate

Notice: I notice you'd like to zip your own coat today.

Nudge: Can you zip with one hand and hold your

coat with the other?

Narrate: You're making that zipper go up, up. Nice

work!
