From the Principal

This is the final newsletter for the year. 2021 has been a year of challenges, achievements and much to celebrate. Thank you to everyone in our school community for your continued support in 2021.

Break up Day

May I remind the school community of the program for Break Up Day. Adults attending the afternoon session must check in using the Check In Qld app upon entering the Hall and physically distance using the seating arrangements. The afternoon session will see the announcement of some special awards and the 2022 School Leaders. Our Senior Choir will also perform on the afternoon.

The final day program will run as follows:

9-11am - Class activities

11am – Free Ice blocks for all students at morning tea

11:30 – 1:15pm – Class activities

1:15- 1:45pm – Watermelon at second break in normal eat areas

1:45 -1:55pm – Wash hands and face, mark class rolls and head to Hall

2-3pm – Hall for Year 6 Ringing of Bell/Photo distribution, Announcement of Special Awards and 2022 School Leaders and Senior Choir

Please note that when in the Hall special seating will be set up for students to separate from all adults/parents. All parents and adults should wait to be guided to your seating area.

Parents/Adults must sign in using the Qld Check In App and hand sanitise upon entry. Covid Safe measures including social distancing will be required in the Hall.

CRI Christmas Performance

The Somerset Religious Instruction group have again organised for schools of the Somerset Region a Free Special Christmas Concert on the morning of Thursday 9 December.

Dan Warlow (puppeteer and kids presenter) will perform a high quality Christmas concert. This concert does contain Christian content but is suitable for all children including those that do not normally attend CRI on a weekly basis. Students that do attend CRI on a weekly basis do not need consent to attend however as it is open to all students, any student that does not normally attend the weekly CRI lessons may attend with parental consent only. Consent forms are attached to this newsletter and have been handed out to all individual students today to take home.

Swimming Carnival

Normally the first event commences around 9:30am after several bus loads of students and staff have been transported across to the pool. The carnival is usually completed by 1pm. As per previous years the school will cover all costs for bus transport and pool entry for swimming carnival competitors.

Year 7 Lowood State High transition days

Reminder that all students in Year 6 that are enrolled at Lowood State High School for 2022 are required to attend your transition days Monday 6 and Tuesday 7 December as per the information that you have already been given. All other Year 6 students are expected to attend Fernvale SS as per normal on these days.

Once the customer clicks on the link the **BPOINT** page opens up and pre-fills all the required information.




