Parents and carers are reminded that all Fernvale students wishing to attend the School Disco on Friday 13 June should purchase their "ticket" online through the Qkr! app. This is the same app used for Tuckshop and uniforms orders. This event is a school fundraiser to offset costs for the upcoming Year 6 camp. The Year 6 camp is the most expensive camp cost in excess of \$30 000 in total costs for the cohort of students. Every cent of fundraising will reduce this cost for parents.

The school disco is only for Fernvale State School Prep to Year 6 students. Older high school siblings are not permitted to attend this disco fundraiser. Student costs to attend the fundraising disco is \$6 per student or \$12 for two or more Fernvale students of the same family. Please ensure that you have ordered and paid for children's tickets online through the Qkr! app.

Parents are cordially invited to assist on the evening, as food and drinks will be on offer for the students. If you are able to assist please let the office ladies know and our parent co-ordinator (Mrs Kelly Clark) will then be able to assign volunteer work rosters for the evening.

Classroom visits and Report Card preparation

Our staff and students are all working extremely hard as they come into that period of the semester when many assessment tasks are being undertaken and teachers commence writing semester report cards. Report card writing is more than just what parents and carers read on "paper". Many hours of assessment are collated by teachers, reviewed, academic work moderated with cohort teams and other staff, comments drafted and finalised all before the report card is issued. Classes and students are well into the completing assessment tasks in the process and will continue through the course of this week.

Over the past week and through the next week or two, members of the Leadership team will also be visiting every class across the school to view a Math lesson (or other as negotiated with the class teacher) to observe the teacher practice and provide feedback. This process is designed to affirm the solid quality practices occurring in all classes and also to provide feedback to each teacher to self-reflect and promote opportunities for improvement.

Year 2 Swimming




You'll find information on topics like dealing with worries and making friends, as well as ideas for day-to-day life, like creating family routines, looking after yourself






Fernvale State School Choir Wins GOLD!
